

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

The customer is in charge of the cleaning of the cottage during their stay. You can also order the clean up as a chargeable extra service. If the cottage is not cleaned the landlord has the right to charge a cleaning fee (minimum 150 euros).

Even if the cleanup service has been ordered the cottage should be generally tidy. All the rubbish should be collected and the fridge and freezer emptied the furniture in its right place. All bottles should be collected into plastic bags and shattered glass should be collected. The cottage should be in such condition that a normal cleanup will make the cottage OK for the next tenant.

If the cleaning service is not ordered the tenant should complete the following checklist.

- All the linen is off the beds and the beds are made. If you are using rented linen you can leave the used linen in a pile next to the door.
- Everything is in its right place (furniture and carpets etc.)
- All dishes are washed
- The stove, oven and microwave are clean (don't forget the oven sheets)
- Make sure the coffee maker, kettle and toaster are clean
- Empty the fireplace, close the damper and make sure there is a full basket of firewood.
- All surfaces are clean and dusted.
- Bathrooms are clean. Toilets seats, sinks and mirrors are clean and the floors of the showers and sauna are clean.
- The floors are hovered and mopped. Remember to also clean under the beds and other furniture.
- The rubbish has been taken out and the bins are tidy.
- Hot tub is empty and clean. There will be sand on the bottom of the tub because the hot tub uses water from the river.
- The plugs of the hot tub are in their place on the top of the fireplace.
- The outside areas are tidy and all rubbish and cigarette buds are cleared out.
- All pet droppings have been cleared out.
- Doors and windows are closed and locked.**

Please leave the cottage in the same condition as it was when you arrived.
